60 Years of Christian Camping ministry for the Christian Brethren Assemblies in Tasmania

We praise God for His hand of blessing over these wonderful years of serving Him, and reaching out with the Gospel message through the camping ministry.

Highlights of Camp Clayton's ministry include:

- Eight children's Holiday Camps every year, introducing children to the Gospel, and developing young Christian leaders
- "Raucous" Camp for teenagers - Grades 9-12
- Youth Leadership Training Weekends to train and develop young leaders
- Solo Sons Camps for boys aged 8-12 who do not have significant males in their lives
- Bella Vita Camps for young single mums
- The "Super Squad" Summer Staff Program offering a mini-internship program on site for young people
- A Wilderness Expedition bushwalking camp each year
- The Golden Ambassadors Retreat
- The Roaring Forties Weekend
- A new Twenty Something Weekend
- Lifeworks Programs offering Christian input programs to the schools

The Development Fund

Under God's Guidance, both Courageous Vision and Careful Stewardship have been key ingredients that have seen successful capital developments throughout Camp Clayton's history.

- In 1978 the 'Wilson Property' was purchased, extending the CYC property to the beach
- The early kitchen was extended and remodeled in 1978
- The new Lodges were completed in 1983
- Bayside Lodge was completed in 1994
- The Stadium was constructed in 1999
- The new kitchen dining and upstairs seminar facility was completed in 2001
- A new range of Outdoor Activities was installed in 2004
- Parkdown Lodges were renovated in 2006

Each of these projects have been able to be funded through the faithfulness of people willing to invest their money in the Development Fund—as either interest-bearing or interest-free loans, or through donations which are tax-deductible.

Throughout Camp Clayton's history, this has meant that commercial borrowing has never yet been necessary and investors have always had access to their funds when required.
